Use of English: Reported speech - statements

When we tell people what someone said, we usually change the tense, because what they said was in the past.

direct speech	tense change	reported speech
Sam:		Rashid:
'I'm at the airport.'	am / are / is → was / were	He said he was at the airport.
'I'm sitting in the departures lounge.'		He said he was sitting in the departures lounge.
'I want to buy you a present.'	present simple → past simple	He said he wanted to buy me a present.

In reported speech: 1) We change the nouns/pronouns
2) We change the tense
3) We add said/told (that)

Aisha: I am happy. Aisha said she was happy.

Aisha: I want to
do to Dubai.

Aisha said she wanted to go to
Dubai.

Aisha: I am watching Aisha said she was watching TV. TV.
